What Is It?

- Move is a week-long high school event held all over the country. It is designed to amplify the call of Christ on students' lives to become kingdom workers. This is done through high energy worship and engaging teaching.

When Is It?

What's the cost of Move 2019? *

- \$350 (rock-bottom price January 6-January 13, 2019) **

- **Registration closes May 19th or when registration is full, whichever comes first.**

Technology Policy

- Leaders will be collecting all phones during group discussions and at lights out time in order to avoid unhealthy distractions and ensure that students get the sleep they need to fuel a great trip. Please plan accordingly.
- If phones become a serious distraction or are used inappropriately, they will be held by the campus pastor until the trip is over.
