- Be a teenager of whom students can model lifestyle choices, behavior, and Christ-like character. This means (but isn’t limited to) refraining from activity illegal for minors, keeping a drama-free social media presence, shutting down gossip, supporting leadership, etc.
- Be a teenager willing to follow the leader.
- Be a teenager with a willing and teachable spirit, taking part in continued training opportunities, leader’s meetings and fellowship.
- Be a teenager with a flexible attitude.
- Be a teenager with a heart to see their friends come to Christ – and live in His fullness.
- Be a teenager familiar with the job description in the area in which you serve – willing to complete the tasks as unto the Lord and loving students in the process.
